



BULL RUN

Rules & Regulations

1. Registration must be submitted to 2Frenzied registration team prior to Sunday 4th July 2010 at 6 PM
2. Registration Fee \$25.00 per team. Winner takes all – All registration fees will be given to the overall winner of the race.
3. To be eligible to race in the Bull Run for prizes a rider must be of Caymanian nationality, status holder or hold at least a one (1) year work permit to work in the Cayman Islands.
4. Each rider (including backup rider) must complete a rider registration form in addition to the team registration form.
5. **All watercrafts will be inspected on race day at 12:30PM**
6. On Monday 5th July 2010 all riders must report to the Beach under the Riders Tent next to *Mrs Vivienne's Kitchen, Gun Bay East End* at 11:30 AM for a short meeting before the race that will begin at 1 PM.
7. We recommend that riders familiarise themselves with the Bull Run ¼ mile race course.
8. Bull Run 1/4 Mile Race will be as follows (**Race What Ya Brung**):
 - *Holding start*
 - *Two (2) false starts will result in disqualification by the Race Marshal*
 - *There will be two (2) race heats selected randomly by a draw*
 - *1st round of each heat will be the qualifying round best of three (3) races, with the top four (4) of each heat advancing to the quarter finals*
 - *Quarter finals of each heat will be single elimination to advance to semi-finals*
 - *Semi-finals of each heat will be single elimination to advance to finals*
 - *Winner from each heat of semi final race will compete for 1st and 2nd place*
 - *Loser from each heat of the semi-finals will compete for 3rd 4th place*
 - *Trophy and the winning cash prize (all registration fees) will be given to the 1st place winner only.*
9. **No alcohol consumption** will be tolerated during the race. Race officials reserve the right to disqualify a team if any of the riders are found to be consuming alcohol during the race.
10. Any competitor exhibiting dangerous or unsportsmanlike conduct at any time during the event may be penalised at the discretion of the Race Marshal.
11. In the event there is a protest of any thing with the races only the designated Team Manager may bring forth the protest to the Race Marshall **ONLY**. All protest must be handled in a professional and sportsmanlike manner once the races are completed.
12. **THE RACE MARSHAL'S DECISION IS FINAL.**
13. Point System:
 - Win = 3 points
 - Tie = 1 point
 - DNF or Loose = 0 points
14. All riders are **required** to wear the following to participate in Both Races:
 - Helmet
 - Gloves
 - Shoes
 - Life Vest
